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4. First Aid Measures

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General Note	In case of accident or if you feel unwell, seek medical advice immediately (show the label where possible) (S45)
Eye Contact	If substance has got into eyes, immediately wash out with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes Irrigate eyes thoroughly whilst lifting eyelids When in doubt or symptoms persist, seek medical attention
Skin Contact	Remove contaminated clothing immediately and drench affected skin with plenty of water. Contaminated clothing should be laundered before reuse Seek medical attention if irritation persist.
Inhalation:	Remove patient to fresh air .Seek medical attention if ill effects occur
Ingestion:	Do not induce vomiting because of risk of aspiration into the lungs. If aspiration is suspected obtain immediate medical attention. If vomiting occurs turn patient on side Obtain immediate medical attention

6. Accidental Release Measures

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Small Spillage	Clean up all spills immediately. Avoid breathing vapours and contact with skin and eyes. Control personal contact with the substance, by using protective equipment.
Large Spillage	Minor hazard. Clear area of personnel. Alert Fire Brigade and tell them location and nature of hazard.
Personal Protection	Remove persons to safety. Wear breathing apparatus if exposed to vapours/dust/spray/gases.
Environmental Precaution	Keep away from drains, surface and ground water. Retain contaminated washing water and dispose it.

Methods and materials for containment and cleaning	Covering of drains. Wipe up with absorbent material (e.g. cloth, fleece). Collect spillage (sawdust, diatonic soil, sand, universalbinder). Neutralisation techniques - Use of adsorbent materials. Place in appropriate containers for disposal. Ventilate affected area.
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7. Handling and Storage

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Handling	Avoid all personal contact, including inhalation. Wear protective clothing when risk of exposure occurs. Use in a well-ventilated area. DO NOT allow clothing wet with material to stay in contact with skin
Storage	Store in original containers. Keep containers securely sealed. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area.
Advice on general occupational hygiene	Wash hands after use. Do not to eat, drink and smoke in work areas. Remove contaminated clothing and protective equipment before entering eating areas. Never keep food or drink in the vicinity of chemicals. Never place chemicals in containers that are normally used for food or drink.
